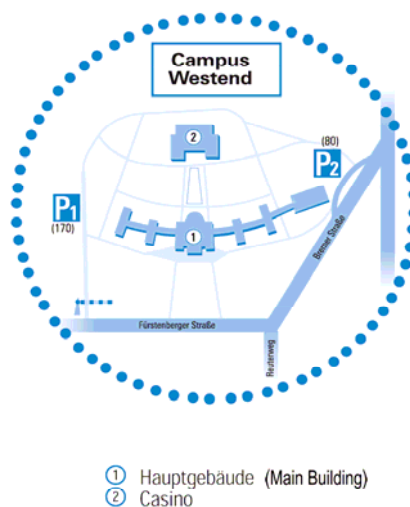

How to get there

By car

- At Nordwestkreuz Frankfurt (freeway A5/A66) take freeway A66 direction F-Stadtmitte/Miquelallee.
- The freeway ends at the city boundary and becomes Miquelallee.
- At the first traffic light turn right into Hansaallee.
- Leave Hansaallee at the second traffic light and turn right into Bremer Straße.
- At the next traffic light turn right into Fürstenberger Straße.
- After approx. 500 m, just before the roundabout, turn right and drive onto the Campusground/Grüneburgplatz.
- Either register at the barrier or drive to one of the marked parking spots.

By public transport

- Underground lines U1, U2, U3, get off at stop "Holzhausenstraße", then walk 300 m along Bremer Straße to the Campus.
- Bus lines 36, 75, get off at stop "Campus Westend/Universität".
